Write a prayer to God thanking Him for giving you wisdom. Ask Him to show you how He is making you wise.





The Wisdom Game Show

Say: We learned this weekend that God will give wisdom to anyone who asks! That means no matter how young you are, God wants you to make wise choices. We're going to play a simple game to help us remember what we've learned about wisdom the last couple of weeks and think more about how we can live wise lives!

Directions: This is a simple "game show" style game. Choose two children to go head to head. Ask one of the following questions and instruct the children to raise their hand as soon as they have an answer. The child who raises their hand first gets to answer. Choose another two children for the next question. Keep going until you've gone through all of the questions. If you have time, go back through the questions with different combinations of children.

- Why is wisdom so valuable?
- Why does God want us to have godly friends?
- How can we use our words wisely?
- What is one way we can show compassion to others?
- How do you think living wisely can help you make a difference in the world?
- How can you be a good friend?
- Who can you use your words to encourage this week?
- Who can you show compassion to this week?
- What was one of the small creatures God said was wise and how were they wise?

Say: We have learned so much about wisdom over the last couple of weeks! I hope you will always remember what God's Word teaches us about living wisely - and that you'd live wisely now and always!
